Who should attend The Artist Summit?

Professional makeup artist, beauty and salon industry professionals, beauty business and salon owners, entrepreneurs and students of beauty and makeup.

What is the schedule for the program?

The program begins with a Welcome Reception on Sunday evening October 4. The three-day program runs Monday, October 5 – Wednesday, October 7. Each day consists of 60-90 minute keynote that run from 9:00 am – 6:00 pm.

Where can I get a list of the sessions being presented?

The specific program selection and schedule will be announced in early 2026 and will be available online on the event webpage.

Are accommodations included in the cost of participation?

Accommodations are not included in the event rates. Our host property, Provincetown Inn, has rates starting at \$129/night plus taxes and fees for attendees of The Artist Summit. This is the preferred accommodation for all attendees.

Are meals included in the cost of participation?

Lunch is included during each day of the program and is included in your event rate. Breakfast is available at Provincetown Inn or in town at the attendee's expense.

How much does it cost to participate?

The Artists Summit early registration rate (before May 1) for TPG Pro members is \$790.00. After May 1, the rate is \$890.00

For those not eligible for that rate, the program cost is always \$990.00 with no early registration rate.

Do I need to pay all of the rate at once?

You can secure your rate and participation with your \$190.00 deposit and pay over time before the start of the event.

What is included in my event fee?

Full participation in all The Artist Summit programs, our welcome gathering on Sunday evening, and lunch each day of the Summit, a TAS tote as well as a range of gifts from our program sponsors.

Is there a discount for Union artists?

Union artists are offered the TPG Pro member pricing.

Is there a discount for students?

Students are offered the TPG Pro member pricing.

Is there a discount for teachers?

Teachers at any beauty industry accredited education program are offered the TPG Pro member pricing.

Is there a group discount rate?

Due to the limited capacity of the program, tickets must be purchased individually, and group rates are not offered.

Where is The Artist Summit located?

The Artist Summit will be located in Provincetown, MA on Cape Cod. All sessions will be held at The Provincetown Inn, 1 Commercial Street in Provincetown, MA.

Can I attend only one day, or do I need to participate in all days?

The program is not available for single day participation and should be participated in for the full three-day program. However, if an attendee is not available for part of the program, they may still participate in other days/portions of the event. Program rate is the same whether participating in all or some of the program.

What are the maximum attendees allowed to participate?

The maximum number of in person participants is 80.

Is the event for beginner or more experienced Artists?

The event has been designed for all levels of experience and attendees will all benefit from the broad range of speakers and topics that are focused on a 360 degree approach to personal and career development.

Are there still hands-on workshops at The Artist Summit?

There are no longer hands-on workshops being offered after the main summit program.

Will I be able to buy products there?

There is no retail portion of The Artist Summit. The event was created strictly as a personal and career development and inspirational program.

If I pay for my participation and can't come, may I receive a refund?

As the event has a limited capacity deposits are non-refundable. If you are unable to attend, we are happy to provide you credit toward any other The Powder Group produced event or products.
